- Continually review and update procedures to ensure they are valid and appropriate.

To assist in these objectives, Bedrock employees and sub-contractors shall:

- Comply with the requirements of the Bedrock QHSE Management System.
- Report Environmental concerns and poor environmental conditions immediately to their line manager or a Bedrock Director.
- Consider environmental aspc risk assessments, Job Safety Analyses, pre-job briefing / toolbox talks and safety meetings.
