

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY



To achieve this, the Company will:

- Set Health and Safety as the top priority for all projects.
- Develop a culture of Health and Safety observance throughout the Company and ensure that all employees and those involved in our activities understand their responsibilities under our QHSE Management System.
- Regularly review and audit all business activities to ensure that Health, Safety and Security procedures are appropriate and complied with and that any shortfalls or non-compliances are swiftly rectified.
- Ensure that our QHSE Management System is focussed to identify, assess and mitigate risk to Health and Safety in all activities, with the objective of eliminating the potential for injury to personnel, loss of integrity and damage to assets.
- Listen to and address HSE concerns when raised by employees or sub-contractors.

To assist in these objectives, Bedrock employees and sub-contractors shall:

- Comply with the requirements of the Bedrock QHSE Management System.
- Report Health & Safety concerns, unsafe acts or unsafe conditions immediately to their line manager or a Bedrock Director.
- Attend and actively contribute to HSE activities including risk assessments, Job Safety Analyses, pre-job briefing / toolbox talks and safety meetings.
